QUALITY – The implementation of the quality system on this project has seen the transfer of information, as well as the traceability of all information between parties improve vastly from past projects. While there is still some work to do to the system to cover the entire project, Morgans are certainly well on their way to achieving this goal.

SAFETY – No Lost Time Injuries (LTI's) or major accidents have been reported to NDC across the course of the job (currently approx 14 months old). This would suggest that the implemented measures used by Morgans have been effective in preventing injuries and hence, lost productivity.
