### SILT FENCES

- Silt fences will be erected as per contract specifications and engineering drawings.
- Install silt fences on level contours. Silt fences installed on grades will direct concentrated flows with high velocity along the structure causing erosion and should be avoided.
- Both ends of fence should be turned towards likely flow to minimise risk of flow bypassing around both ends of the fence.
- Silt fences must be installed using continuous roll woven fabrics 150mm into existing ground and be supported by star pickets at 3m centres or 50 x 25 hardwood pegs at 2.5m centres.
- Silt fences are to be erected around or along all disturbed area including stockpiles, spoil from trenches and haul roads if contaminated water could enter stormwater drains.
- Silt fences checked & cleared when 50-60% of the capacity is full of sediment, captured sediment is to be removed and spread on site locations where further erosion and or sedimentation is unlikely to occur.

**We have had 3 incidents within a week**

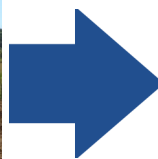
**Water Cart rollover 16.02.16 (near miss)**
